Main duties and responsibilities

- Support the publication of Asia House flagship reports.
- Analyse complex regulatory environments and key economic policy and political initiatives.
- Provide policy advice to clients and corporate members on topics ranging from domestic regulation, macroeconomics, and geopolitics.
- Work closely with the Head of Research and Advisory to identify new commercial opportunities and research products.
- Participate in Focus Group discussions as necessary.
- Lead bespoke, client-commissioned research projects.
- Support the wider Asia House Business and Policy team, which includes convening briefings and events for corporate clients.

Ideal candidate

- A minimum of three years' relevant professional experience in an Asia-focused research/consulting role.
- In-depth knowledge of international trade, macroeconomics, and major business and policy issues in Asia, especially in Southeast Asia.
- Advanced research, analytical, and writing skills.
- Proven track record of managing projects both independently and as part of a team.
- Outstanding project management skills, including the ability to manage high workloads and meet deadlines.
- Experience engaging with senior political and business figures.
